

### Mouse Features

1. You can switch between the 2.4G wireless connection and Bluetooth via the bottom switch. The LED light indicates which mode is active.
2. Bluetooth function supports both Bluetooth 3.0 and 5.0 devices.



### First Use

1. Insert an AA alkaline battery into the mouse with the correct polarity direction, and turn on the power switch on the bottom.

### Mode Switch

1. Make a short press on the mode switch button to switch between Bluetooth and 2.4G Wireless mode. The LED lights will indicate which mode is active.
2. When in 2.4G Wireless mode place the USB receiver into a computer or dock port and the mouse is now ready for use in wireless mode.
3. Press and hold the mode switch button for 3 seconds to enter into Bluetooth pairing. The Bluetooth LED will flash quickly.
4. Open Bluetooth connections on your device and select **BT3.0 Mouse** or **BT5.0 Mouse** from the available device list. When successfully connected the LED will stop flashing quickly and the mouse is now ready for use.

### Troubleshooting 2.4G Wireless mode

1. If the 2.4G Wireless connection is not working please unplug the USB receiver and repeat the pairing steps after confirming that the mouse is in 2.4G mode.
2. Press left button, right button and scroll wheel simultaneously for 3-5 seconds and release them when the LED flashes quickly.
3. Replug the USB receiver into the computer or dock for pairing.

### Troubleshooting Bluetooth mode

1. If the Bluetooth connection is not available on your computer please reboot the mouse.
2. Empty the Bluetooth list on your computer and repeat the Bluetooth pairing process.

If the product is still not working after the above guide please test on another device and contact your vendor for further help.

Please select "**BT3.0 Mouse**" for devices using Windows 7.

Please use "**BT5.0 Mouse**" for devices using Windows 8 or newer.

3. The mouse is equipped with 3 DPI settings (1000/1500/1800) default setting is 1800 DPI. You can switch between them cyclically by pressing the DPI button.
4. The mouse will enter into power saving mode if it's unused for 30 minutes and will wake up when pressing any of the mouse buttons.
5. Please note that side buttons are not available on Mac OS devices.
