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Wheelchair Accessibility

Most of the Strokestown Park grounds used for the event are wheelchair accessible, including the museum, House (ground floor), courtyard, and gardens. Please see pictures attached below.

- ⇒ Gravel paths will be used in the expo area. Assistance may be helpful for manual wheelchair users.
- ⇒ Asphalt paths are available for physical activity demonstrations.
- ⇒ Garden paths are generally wide and smooth for mobility devices.
- ⇒ The nature trail is approximately 1km. About one-third of the trail is buggy friendly. A narrow bridge further along the trail is not suitable for mobility devices.
- ⇒ Ground floor access only in the house. New section of museum is fully accessible by all mobility devices.
- ⇒ Accessible parking is provided on-site near the entrance, with a drop-off zone if needed.
- ⇒ On site accessible cafeteria open throughout the event
- ⇒ Accessible toilets are available

Supports for Participants

- ⇒ A team of volunteers will be available along the route and in key zones to offer assistance as needed.
- ⇒ An area is designated for physical wellness demonstrations such as wheelchair biking and assistive mobility devices if needed.
- ⇒ Accessible toilets are located on-site. A hoist-equipped Changing Places facility is not available.
- ⇒ There will be designated outdoor quiet room.

⇒ An indoor room is allocated for music-based Ceili wheelchair dancing to remain dry in case of rainy weather.

► Tips for Visitors with Mobility Needs

⇒ Arriving early (from 10:30 AM) is recommended to allow time to get settled.

⇒ Bring personal mobility aids or support equipment as needed.

If you have concerns about surfaces, pacing, or require extra support, please feel free to contact the event team in advance.
